

For sale here is a Peleng 8mm circular fisheye which will fit both Canon EOS and Pentax K mount cameras: The lens attaches to the camera via interchangeable mounts; I originally bought the lens fitted with a Pentax mount but swapped camera system to Canon soon after so bought an EOS mount (hence the reason this will fit both manufacturers). The mounts are easily interchangeable using a small screwdriver.

The lens has been very well looked after with no scratches to either the bulbous front element or the rear element. There are no signs of fungus, the aperture blades stop down smoothly and the focussing ring rotates smoothly. Note that both aperture and focus are fully manual on this lens.

If you've read up on this lens then you'll probably realise that focussing is a little tricky. Fortunately due to the extremely small focal length of the Peleng; focussing at infinity gives an in focus shot right down to objects in the foreground. I've found that (due to the thickness of the EOS adapter) to focus at infinity on a Canon you must set the lens at around the 0.22m mark on the lens barrel. The focussing marks on the barrel when using the K mount adaptor on a Pentax camera are accurate.

- 3 x filters (can be used in place of standard rear element)

I'll also supply you with a 'Make Poverty History' band. Why? you may ask...because the lens cap supplied with these lenses are notorious for falling off in camera bags and I've found that this is a rather good way of keeping the cap secure.
